

Beavers Win 28-0 Victory from Arenac

Scoring a touchdown in every quarter, Beaverton High School defeated Arenac Eastern in the home opener for Beaverton, 28-0.

Lee Knapp converted two Arenac fumbles into touchdowns, running 35 yards with one bobble in the first period, and carrying the other 40 yards in the second quarter.

In the third period, Halfback Ken Govitz passed 45 yards to End Bill Grant for a touchdown. Dick McCulloch added the final marker in the last quarter, charging 20 yards. Govitz place-kicked four extra points.

It was Beaverton's second win in three games, while Arenac has won one and lost two.
