

Beavers End Season Friday

Beaverton won its fourth game of the season Friday evening, and remained in a tie for second place by defeating Pinconning there, 20 to 7.

The Beavers broke into the scoring column early in the first quarter, when Farmer clicked on a 15-yard run off right tackle.

In the second quarter, Jake McKimmy, on a reverse play good for 25 yards, put the Beavers out in front, 12 - 0. A pass for the extra point, from Govitz to Guest, made it 13 - 0 at halftime.

In the third quarter, Farmer threw a screen pass to Govitz, who scampered 60 yards for the third tally.

Pinconning scored in the fourth quarter on a 6-yd. line smash.

The Beavers end their football season Friday evening on the local gridiron, when they play host to Houghton Lake. It has been over 20 years since a Houghton Lake team has played on the local field, and the Beavers would like to win this one, since the Lakers kept the Beavers from winning a share of last year's title when they tied them, 13 - 13. The junior varsity will play Houghton Lake jv's at 7 o'clock. The varsity game starts at 8:00.
