

Beavers Add Pinconning

Beaverton High basketball team dropped winless Pinconning 62 to 46 in a home game Friday night.

With Tom Guest leading the way with six points, the victors jumped off to a 17-11 first quarter lead. In the second period, Ken Govitz controlled the ball most of the time. The Beavers had it and scored 12 points to eight for Pinconning, to make the half-time tally, 29-19. The Beavers extended their lead in the third period to 44-29. Coach Ed Wolford emptied the bench in the final quarter but his changes still outscored their opponents 18 to 13 to make the final score 62 to 46. Top scorers for the evening were two Beavers, Govitz with 25 and Guest with 15. Clarence Reeves was top man for Pinconning with 13.

In the J-V game Pinny leaped to a 20 point lead, then hung on for a 46-35 win, their first of the year. Bill Pierson of Pinny was top man with 16 points, while Les Smith and Pat Kalahar each cashed in for 12 points for the Little Beavers.

All Beaverton teams are inactive this week but will have a full schedule next week. The boys will be host to Sterling Tuesday night at 7 p. m. and will travel to Arenac Eastern on Friday while the girls will meet Pinconning at home Wednesday night.
