

# Beavers' Grant Is All-Stater

DETROIT — Dan Grant, Beaverton's outstanding half-back, was named to the second team of the Associated Press Class C All-State football team announced today.

Grant, a tough senior back, led The Saginaw News area in scoring with a total of 138 points and gained over 1,000 yards rushing.

Grant was the sparkplug of a Beaverton team that won eight games against a single setback.

State Class B champion Galesburg-Augusta placed two players on the first team. Grant was the only player from the Saginaw area to be selected for either the first or second team.
