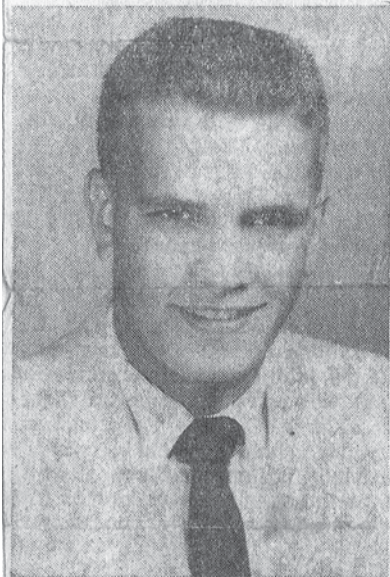


Dick VanWieren

regulars that graduated last year that has hopes of joining college football ranks.

Head Viking football coach Hi Becker has classed VanWieren as a better than average thrower and a wail of a good defensive player.

Becker added that Dick is a very consistent ball player and that the youth never missed a football session, always being one of the first on the field at each practice.

VanWieren played at an end position during his first year with the Vikings, before switching to the quarterback slot.

Dick was offered the full scholarship at Indiana University by head football coach Phil Dicken, after the youth visited the university campus earlier this year.
