BEAVERTON — Beaverton's varsity squad, led by the fine performances of Doyle Durkee and Randy Sroufe, defeated Gladwin Tuesday night, 64-54.

Beaverton dominated the entire game, as Durkee scored 25 points, followed closely by teammate Sroufe who accounted for 24 points.

For Gladwin, Vince Sheehan scored 17 points to lead his team's efforts, while Kevin Hetherington scored 13.

The win opened the season for Beaverton, and Gladwin is now 1-1 for the season. On Friday night both teams open conference play, Beaverton hosting Coleman in the Jack Pine and Gladwin entertaining Essexville-Garber in the Northern B.
