Harrison 55

Beavers 7-0 after romp

BEAVERTON—Beaverton remained undefeated after a 77-55 victory over Jack Pine Conference opponent Harrison Tuesday night. The Beavers, who were ranked 10th in the state in Class C in this week's AP poll, displayed total domination of the game, as four of their players scored in double figures.

Beaverton outscored Harrison in every quarter but the last as it held an eight-point lead at the end of the first quarter. They increased the lead to 22 by the end of the half, and to 28 by the end of the third period. Beaverton gave up six points of their lead in the final period, but by then Harrison had already been soundly defeated.

Doyle Durkee led the way for Beaverton with 16 points. Mike O'Brien was next with 14, followed by Randy Sroufe with 13. Jeff Rohrs dumped in 10 points to help the Beavers on their way.

For Harrison, Joe Brown scored 15 points, as Brad Boulton added 10.

Beaverton had help on the boards from Sroufe and Ken Neighbors. Neighbors brought down 13 rebounds, and Sroufe collected 10. Collectively Beaverton exhibited total control of the boards, pulling down 53 rebounds compared to 25 for Harrison.

Beaverton is now 7-0 for the season, with a 4-0 record in the conference. Harrison is 2-2 in the conference, and 4-3 overall.
